JOB POSTING: Demonstration Garden Educator

Langley Environmental Partners Society (LEPS) is seeking a **Demonstration Garden Educator** to provide nature-based education programs for a children's daycamp (Eco Explorers) in the **Langley Demonstration Garden**, located at the **Derek Doubleday Arboretum**.

Project Description

The mandate of the Langley Demonstration Garden is to provide education to Langley residents on safe home and garden practices including waste management and waste reduction techniques, organic and waterwise gardening, pesticide reduction and sustainable living.

The **Eco Explorers day camps** are geared towards children 6-12 years of age. There are six environmentally based themes, repeated three times each week for six weeks, starting July 9 and ending August 15. See attached document for details. Successful candidate **MUST** be available Tues-Thurs weekly for the duration of the camps.

As the Demonstration Garden Educator you will be responsible for:

Presentations- 95% - Deliver an established kids' education program including teaching and leading educational activities and craft components, with support from garden staff.

Attend Community Events -5%– promote sustainability messages to the public by attending a variety of events throughout the summer (may include evenings and weekends).

Qualifications:

- **Education:** Post Secondary studies in Education, teacher certification an asset.
- **Knowledge and experience in the following topics is an asset:** experience in children's programming and environmental education, event organization, sustainable living practices.
- **Individual qualities:** Flexibility, willingness to learn and a good attitude are essential.
- **Excellent Communicator** with good interpersonal skills, teaching or public speaking skills.
- **Enjoy working with children,** with strong classroom management skills.
- **Successful candidate will need to submit a clean criminal record check.**
