### JOB POSTING: INTERIM ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATOR

#### Description:

Langley Environmental Partners Society (LEPS) is a non-profit, partnership-driven organization formed in 1993 to protect and restore the natural environment through education, cooperation and action.

**We are currently seeking one Interim Environmental Educator** to work as part of the Education Team, assisting with the delivery of environmental education programs, reporting to the Executive Director.

Duties will include:

- **Environmental Education program** (April-June 2022 and Sept- April 2023)
  - i. Deliver presentations to school and community groups both virtually and in person, in classrooms and outdoors;
  - ii. Assist with developing new education program materials.
- **Langley Demonstration Garden** (July – August 2022)
  - i. Develop and deliver an established kids' outdoor education program including creating lesson plans, teaching, and leading educational activities and craft components;
  - ii. Assist in promoting garden workshops and management of program registration.

Other duties may include:

- Assisting with the exhibition of interactive displays at community events;
- Providing support to other program areas, as required.

#### Qualifications:

Education: College diploma or university degree in education, environment or related field, or equivalent combination of experience.

Experience: Minimum 2-3 years direct experience in program management; teaching and leading programs for children and youth; knowledge of stream ecology, watershed stewardship, and/or other outdoor specializations.
